

**Did the Early Christians Think that the End was Imminent?
If so, what other errors did they make in the Scriptures?**

Last Day(s)

- John 11:24 Rise again at the last day
- John 12:48 The words I have spoken will judge him in the last day
- Acts 2:17 (quoting Joel) Come to pass in the last days (verse 16, Peter applied it to his time)
- 1 Corinthians 15:52 The last trumpet
- 2 Timothy 3:1 In the last days perilous times will come (verse 9, progress no further)
- Hebrews 1:2 In these last days has spoken through His Son
- James 5:3 Heaped up treasure in the last days (verse 8, at hand)
- 1 Peter 1:5 Revealed in the last time (verses 7 and 13, revelation of Jesus) (verse 6, for a little while)
- 1 Peter 1:20 Manifest in these last times for you
- 2 Peter 3:3 Scoffers will come in the last days (verse 10, heavens pass away)
- Jude 18 Mockers in the last time (verse 17, apostles prepared the readers for these mockers)

The End

- 1 Peter 4:7 The end of all things is at hand
- Hebrews 9:26 Jesus appeared on earth at the end of the ages
- 1 Corinthians 10:11 Upon whom the ends of the ages have come

Coming

- Matthew 16:28 Not taste death until He comes
- Matthew 24:3 What will be the sign of your coming and the end of the age? Answers both questions in sequence. The reference to Daniel (verse 15) predicts the destruction of Jerusalem, as confirmed by the parallel passage in Luke 21:20, "When you see the city surrounded by armies." See verses 27, 30, 37, 39, and 44.
- Matthew 26:64, Mark 13:26, Mark 14:62, and Luke 21:27, reference to Daniel 7:13
- 1 Corinthians 15:23 Resurrection . . . at His coming (Judgment)
- 1 Thessalonians 2:19 at His coming
- 1 Thessalonians 3:13 at His coming
- 1 Thessalonians 4:15 We who are alive...at the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who have fallen asleep.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 At the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ
- 2 Thessalonians 2:1 The coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (verse 8, destroy the lawless one with the brightness of His coming)
- James 5:7 Be patient until the coming of the Lord (verse 8, the coming of the Lord is at hand)
- 2 Peter 1:16 Made known to you the power and coming of our Lord, and were eyewitnesses.
- 2 Peter 3:4 Where is the promise of His coming? (verse 12, coming of the day of God) (verse 10, heavens will pass away)
- 1 John 2:28 Not be ashamed at His coming
